Annie E. Casey Foundation releases 2008 KIDS COUNT Data Book (<http://www.aecf.org>)

The data book reports that national trends in child well-being taken together have improved slightly since 2000, even as more children are living in relative poverty in the United States than in any other economically advanced nation. According to the data book, child death rate, teen death rate, teen birth rate, high school dropout rate, and teens not in school and not working showed improvement. New Hampshire, Minnesota, and Massachusetts rank highest in terms of child well-being, while New Mexico, Louisiana, and Mississippi rank lowest.
