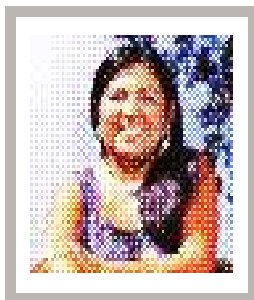

United Way to Target Health, Education, and Income

United Way (<http://liveunited.org/>) has announced that it will direct most of its giving toward a ten-year effort to halve high school dropout rate and number of working families struggling financially while increasing by a third the number of youths and adults considered healthy. The announcement coincides with the release of a United Way report detailing a decline in education, personal finance, and health indicators. According to the report, "Goals for the Common Good," a quarter of all high school students do not graduate on time, one in four families does not earn enough to provide for its members, and two in three young people and adults lead unhealthy lives.
